Minutes: May 2016

The May 26th meeting was held at the Mount Pleasant Community Center with 30 members present. A moment of silence was held for mother of member Juanita Chase.

Minutes: The minutes of the April meeting were read by Marilyn. Moved by Marilyn, seconded by Kevin, "The April minutes are approved as presented". Carried.

Treasurer's Report: Villa presented her financial report. Moved by Villa, seconded by David, "The Treasurer's report is approved as presented." Carried.

Old Business

1. **Demo Day:** This event was held May 14th and it was deemed to be a successful event.
2. **Spring Rally:** The start location will be Ellis Bridge and parking in the upper field. The routes will include Balancing Rock, Chimney Rock and the noon BBQ will be held at Gorby Gulch. Volunteer members agreed to post signage for the trail and co-ordinate the registration. It was noted that area Cadets will be using the Skedaddle Ridge trails for their camping trip in the McIntosh Brook, Golden Ridge and East Knowlesville area. ATV participants should be aware of their event during the same day as the Rally.

New Business:

1. **Pokiok Bridge:** A work day is planned for Sat. June 11th to conduct necessary repairs. It was noted The Torque dealer is supporting this project by providing lumber, transportation and labour for the deck replacement of this bridge.
2. **Galloway Bridge:** This covered bridge, McKenzie Rest area, requires a sheet of floor plywood.
3. **Culvert:** South Ridge road needs replacement. It was suggested to check with Twin River. It was noted the culvert at Orser Camp area has been fixed.
4. **Trail Map:** Since the last meeting this initiative has addressed some issues. It was noted that the Nashwaak Valley ATV Club has proposed a route connecting from the McGivney area to the Craig Brook area as well as an alternate lower route from Cedar Bridge to McBeen Brook. The proposed Sisson Mine area had to be taken into consideration for this route. NBATVF Trail Manager Ben Cyr has been requested to initiate the required documentation for this route as it will be part of the Prov. Trail. Maps should be available for the Spring Rally on June 4th.
