Trails 5118 and 5148 remain closed due to downed trees and beaver damage. Trail 17 requires brushing work. Repairs to Barry's Bridge on 5108 and culverts on #17 to be scheduled. Work day has been scheduled for June 21 on trails south of route 107.

Mapping: New paper trail maps will be issued in June. Feedback from last year's version has been taken into account for visual styling and added EMS information.

New Positions: calls for volunteers to temporarily assist with Secretary duties, as well as a new Project Director role to manage contractors/projects.

Regional Director's Update: New club at Meductic is progressing well. A recent meeting was held with Western NB Service Commission and local ATV and Snowmobile club representatives to discuss current and future usage of the Trans-Canada trail system with the intention to grow tourism and possible connections to amenities and existing trails. A survey is live for the public to give input on current trail usage; members are encouraged to complete.

Open Floor:

Sarah has reached out to the mayor of District of Carleton North to begin discussions on bylaw revisions allowing ATV access on certain public roads to access amenities in Bath.
