Called to order at 7 pm

Sarah acknowledged those that are under the weather and that had lost loved ones in the past months

The minutes of the last meeting were read and on a motion by Wilmot and seconded by Kevin were accepted as read.

Grant gave the treasurer's report

Old Business

- Club trailer was taken to Highlift Auto for inspection
- Chimney Rock the ladder has to come out as it is not safe and it is our responsibility to remediate it along with a guard rails and signs directing people where to walk, Sarah made inquiries to the proper government authorities as to what is to be put in place awaiting their reply. It was felt we should take pictures before and after.
- Spring Rally :Discussed things to help out with the rally.
Agreed that First prize would be a 17 in Blackstone, Yeti cooler and a \$150 certificate from CNC.
Second prize would be 2 rain suits
Third would be 1 trail pass and hat

New Business

Wind farm update: They will be shutting down the center of our trail system for 2 years.

Sarah presented a map of proposed new trails around the closure if approved.

There would have to be new signs and change our maps to reflect the changes and the club has to put up trail closed signs on the affected trails.

Regional Director Update

No update on the railbed from the Regional Resource commission or Mayors of the area.

People are asking why they can't get on the trails now but the law states April 15 before offroad vehicles can travel trails because the Snowmobile clubs have access until then on some of the trails.

Open Floor

- Sarah told about the call she got from an Ontario number it was a side by side stuck on a trail in Drummond he had tried other numbers but she was the first to call back.
- Discussed meeting location. There was a vote called for live streaming the meetings and there was 1 vote for it.
- Discussed having guest speakers, it was felt it should be someone connected to the community i.e.: public safety, RCMP, Sarah will pick someone.
- Sarah explained the three membership categories:
 1. you are member when you buy a trail pass
 2. Associate Member for a \$10 fee is someone who does not have a machine or is a second rider but wants to have the same rights and privileges as a member.
 3. Honorary Member is a long-time member and is nominated for the Honorary membership
- Kelly provided pricing for sea cans for storage, to be discussed with directors
